Players must also be able to mark the board or arrange to have someone that will mark for them at the event.

You should bring your membership card to all Grand Prix Events and should be shown for registration.

In the case of a Membership Card being lost or damaged and required to be replaced you will be required to pay £5 for the new Card

Being a Member allows the Top 4 boys and Top 2 girls at the end of the year will automatically qualify to play in the World Masters Qualifiers.

Being a member gives you the chance to take part in all Youth Tour events in 2020 and if eligible you will be considered for Selection for the Scottish Youth Team.

Being a member entitles you to receive an invitations through the Winmau Scottish Youth Grand Prix Table and Winmau Scottish Youth Future Stars Table into the Invitational Matchplay events at the end of the season.

Being a member entitles you entry into 4 free Prize Draws specifically where one of the Youth Members will win a Blade 5 Dartboard in each draw. (other prizes may be available)

Each year Scottish Dart Association selects International Teams in Girls and Boys categories to participate in international events, this is a huge honour for those who are selected and part of a group of players that have represented Scotland at Youth Level who have then gone on in the sport and represent the Country at Seniors Level.

The team usually consists of 4 Boys and 2 Girls which usually participate annually in the British Internationals and Europe Cup Youth, on every odd numbered year the team has competed in the World Cup as well, however this is decided at the time and the teams for this consists of only 2 Boys & 2 Girls.

Scottish Darts Association has a zero tolerance policy against Bullying and Disciplinary Remarks and any individual or group who subject any other individual or group to bullying or hateful remarks whether at an event or on Social Media will be disciplined accordingly.

Should any player take to social media or be found to be verbally abusing any member of the Scottish Directors, Scotland Youth Committee or officials personally, or be found to be bringing the company into disrepute, the Scottish Darts Association reserves the right to take action against these individuals or groups.

Any player in the National Sides are representing the Association and therefore are considered ambassadors and are expected that their conduct at Scottish Events, International Events and events outside the Association is respectful and sporting, any player failing to meet these standards may receive disciplinary action as they will be considered to be bringing the Association into disrepute.

If you ever experience any issues in the form of Bullying and/or discriminatory remarks we encourage all incidents to be reported and will remain 100% confidential until a formal complaint has been made, we operate a Zero Tolerance Policy for any offences of this nature and anyone found guilty of such an offence will receive disciplinary action from Scottish Darts Association.

Any player who feels the need to contact us may speak to any of the officials or message them, or Sharon Macfarlane – Youth Director and will advise you of the options available before an official complaint is submitted.
